The sand hills of the Roero and sunny, on the left bank of the Tanaro River is the perfect setting to make elegant wines, fruity and rich floral sensation. The Arneis grape is a demanding, intriguing and fascinating. The wine is made from soft pressing of the grapes and the white fermentation at low temperature of the wort. Does not require long periods of aging and you can already enjoy from the early months of the year following the harvest.

Appellation: Roero Arneis DOC
Town: Sunrise and Trezzo Tinella.
Exposition: South (Alba), Southeast (Trezzo Tinella).
Vine: Arneis.

Breeding kind: Guyot
Wine making: The grapes are picked fully ripe and start immediately to winemaking. The must obtained by pressing, stabilized in stainless steel tanks where it matures.

Colour: straw yellow with greenish reflections.
Bouquet: delicate and intense, herbaceous.

Taste: dry, full-bodied and enveloping.
